

EVALUATION VISIT

This appointment is to assess your prosthetic needs and begin the insurance paperwork process

CASTING VISIT

Measurements and casting of the residual limb starts the creation of your custom prosthesis

The fitting and alignment of the test socket will happen 2 to 14 days after your casting visit. Socket adjustments and basic gait training occur at this visit. Multiple test socket appointments may be required based on your needs
